Oversized antique bricks salvaged from the 19th century make a bold design statement in the 21st century. Rescued from demolished buildings throughout the Midwest, they come in a wide range of shades from dark red/purple to oranges, pinks and buffs.

### Unit Specifications

Gavin Historical Bricks Reclaimed Building Bricks have been independently tested and conform to the requirements of American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) Standard Specification C216, Grade MW, Type FBA\* and all grades of ASTM C62.



When specifying this this product, the specifications should cite:

- 1) The supplier as "Gavin Historical Bricks."
- 2) Conformance to the requirements of the appropriate standard (typically, ASTM C216).
- 3) The general dimensions listed as thickness x height x length.
- 4) Color\*

Example: Reclaimed Building Bricks supplied by Gavin Historical Bricks to conform to the requirements of ASTM C216, Grade MW, Type FBA. The units have a general dimension of 4" x 2 3/8" x 8"\*\*.

\*Confirm available colors and approve with physical sample: Antique Mixed Red, Old Chicago, St. Louis, Buff Handmade, etc.

\*\*It is understood that reclaimed bricks will have some chips, imperfections and irregularities and that it is the aesthetic intent of the specifier.
